Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Please receive a greeting full of gratitude and hope from all of us at the conclusion of the **Third Ordinary General Assembly of the Consecrated Women of Regnum Christi**, held in Rome in recent weeks.

We would like to thank you, from the bottom of our hearts, for your prayers, your closeness, and for your fraternal support during this time that is so significant for our Society. It has sustained us to feel accompanied by you and to know that, from different parts of the world, you entrusted us to the Lord in prayer.

During these weeks we have worked on various important aspects of our life and mission: the formulation in our proper law of **the specific contribution that we, as Consecrated Women, make to the shared charism**; the definition of **the vision that will guide the next six years**; the culmination of discernment on the experience of **evangelical poverty**; reflection on **sustainability**; the approval of some **adjustments to our proper law**; and the closing of the process of **discernment on the proposal for a community with a contemplative lifestyle within the Society**. Likewise, as a natural part of this process, the Assembly carried out the **election of the new general government**, who are entrusted the mission of guiding and fostering the life of the Society during the next six-year period, in fidelity to the Holy Spirit and to the charism that we share.

We are especially grateful for how our paths converged during this period, while the Legionaries celebrated their **General Chapter** and the Lay Consecrated Men their own **General Assembly**. This unity has been a concrete expression of the communion that we safeguard together in Regnum Christi.

A particularly significant moment was when we met with the Chapter Fathers and Lay Consecrated Men, as well as the witness of communion lived during the Eucharist presided over by Fr. Carlos Gutiérrez, LC, and Fr. John Connor, LC. We exchanged experiences, listened to what we all resonated with and gave thanks together for the action of the Holy Spirit in our vocations.

We also wish to recall with special gratitude the audience with **Pope Leo XIV, who received us Consecrated Women and the Lay Consecrated Men** with great closeness. The Holy Father delved deeper into the identity of Regnum Christi, the communion between our vocations, and the call to preserve the charism with renewed fidelity. His invitation to "promote an ever-wider communion throughout the Family, sharing spirituality and apostolate" becomes a commitment and common effort for all of us.

These experiences confirmed the grace of walking together in the service of the Church, bringing to life the conclusions of the General Convention of Regnum Christi that have been integrated into our 2032 vision.

During the Assembly we reaffirmed that the charism we share is a gift entrusted to our shared responsibility, and that its authenticity is protected and made fruitful through collaboration, communion, and mission lived as an apostolic body. We therefore renew our desire to continue working together, in deep communion with you, to proclaim Christ with renewed ardor and to respond to the current challenges of evangelization.

With joy, we share with you the **Final Communiqué of the General Assembly**, which includes the orientations and decisions made throughout this time of prayer and community discernment. We thank you in advance for your interest and we hope that this document will further strengthen our shared mission.

Dear brothers and sisters, thank you once again for your closeness, your prayers, and for walking alongside us. We renew our willingness to collaborate fraternally and to safeguard, together, the charism we have received.
